Sonohysterogram

Why do I need one?

- Your medical provider wants to view the lining of your uterus
- The procedure can help diagnose abnormal bleeding, growths or scarring inside the uterus and can help determine treatment plan

How is it done?

- You will have a transvaginal ultrasound performed after you empty your bladder
- Your medical provider will come in and insert a speculum into your vagina, wash your cervix and then insert a catheter into your cervix
- The transvaginal probe is then inserted
- Your medical provider will inject a sterile saline solution into your uterus
- Ultrasound images will then be taken with the fluid in the cavity

What should I expect after the procedure?

- Cramping
- Watery discharge
- Spotting
